Facts:

- This is a water only increase, sewer rates are not affected
- This is not an increase borne by Grand Blanc Township
- The meter equivalency system places the majority of the burden on those with larger meters who have more demand on the system.
- This increase is being passed down by Genesee County to all communities in Genesee County
- This increase is in response to the City of Flint withdrawing from the new Karegoni Water Authority.
- The increase also includes our final increase from the Detroit Water and Sewer Department.
- Although the RTS is going up substantially for some, the commodity rate is being lowered to help offset the increase.
 - This means you will pay more for the RTS and less for the usage.
- Rates could be reduced in the future after the KWA and GCDC water treatment plant have ran for a year or two proving their cost of operations and a rate analysis is completed.
- The Township is expected to switch to the new water source sometime this fall or early winter (November/December). Residents will see no interruptions.
